#### South Africa & the Anzacs in the First World War



Forty-four convoys took the Anzacs to the battlefields of the Great War. Many of them transited vis South Africa including the Ports of Cape Town and Durban. What was their reception like? We have some clues in our library. The flimsy flier from Cape Town, reveals that the AIF, NZEF and YMCA had combined to welcome those Anzacs lucky enough to be allowed ashore. The "Don'ts" (sic) are interesting: one says — "Don't encourage familiarity with coloured races—neither you nor your own folk desire it".

Convoys that called at Durban were greeted by Miss Ethel Campbell, the "Angel of Durban". Her figure could be seen from far out to sea, flashing a message of welcome in semaphore. She carried baskets brimming with oranges, jams cooked in her kitchen, books, magazines and tobacco. The gifts were thrown up on the decks of the transports and men made sport of catching them. Those permitted to land were treated to a tour of the town, the sociable Miss Campbell their lively companion.
