The earliest publication of USI of Victoria (our former name) was far removed from today's e-newsletters. Our Journal was published from 1890 (our year of founding) to 1896 and printed by the Government Printer, showing the close relationship between government and USI. This copy (Vol IV, No III, July 1895), edited by our then secretary, Captain John Monash, is one of the earliest issues we have in our collection. It shows our office address as 178 Collins St. It was one of several copies donated to us in April.
